
Annual Sports Day

Notice

1. Assembly

Students should arrive at the Sham Shui Po Sports Ground (within walking distance from Sham Shui Po MTR station) before 8:15 am on 31st January and 9:30 am on 1st February and those who will participate in the closing ceremony should arrive at 8:30 am on 1st February for rehearsal. All students are required to queue up on the track for roll call and students should sit according to the houses they belong to.

2. Lunch

Lunch time on the sports days is from 12:15 pm to 1:45 pm. After lunch, students need to queue up for roll call.

3. Dress Code

Students are required to wear school uniform while athletes and student helpers can wear school P.E. uniform.

4. Seats

Students who are not participating in any events should remain seated at the designated area of the house.

5. Arrangement for leaving the seats

Should students want to go the washroom, they have to get permission from teachers first. Student I.D. card should be presented to the prefect and the time allowed is 5 minutes. Those who cannot present their student I.D. card are not allowed to leave their seats during the games. Athletes need to go back to their seats right after they finish their events.

6. Beverages

Students, especially athletes, are advised to bring their own bottles of water.

7. Conduct Code

- Bringing valuables to the sports ground is not advised. Please keep an eye on your personal belongings.
- Pokers, magazines and any other kinds of games are forbidden.
- Food or drinks that are not sold at the sports ground are not permitted.
- Chewing gum is prohibited.
- No entry is allowed in the grassland area.
- Keep the venue clean and tidy

8. Proper Attitudes

- Students should follow the school rules when they are at the sports ground.
- Athletes should display sportsmanship while other students also need to show their support and provide assistance if necessary.
- Students who intentionally violate the regulations will be isolated and punished.

9. Medical Treatment and First Aids

In case of any discomfort or injury, please report to the teachers immediately.

10. Weather Condition

Races will be cancelled if the EDB announces that classes of all schools are suspended due to weather conditions. In case of rain, students still need to arrive at the venue as scheduled and wait for the school's contingency measures.

11. Valuables

Valuables such as wallets, mobile phones, etc. can be deposited in the safe box next to the command post.
