Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Implementation of Blended Mode of Learning and "Quality Education Fund e-Learning Funding Programme—Provision of Mobile Computer Devices and Internet Services Support" (2022/23 School Year)

Our school has been implementing the "Bring Your Own Device" policy since the 2020/2021 school year for e-Learning, recommending students to bring their own mobile computer devices to school for learning. To alleviate the financial burden of students from low-income families, we have participated in the "Quality Education Fund e-Learning Funding Programme—Provision of Mobile Computer Devices and Internet Services Support" to apply funding for purchasing mobile computer devices for <u>loan</u> to financially needy students.
