Dear Parents/ Guardians,

**Implementation of Blended Mode of Learning and “Quality Education Fund e-Learning Funding Programme—Provision of Portable Computer Devices and Internet Services Support”
(2021/22 School Year)**

Our school has been implementing the “Bring Your Own Device” policy since the 2020/2021 school year for e-Learning. To alleviate the financial burden of students from underprivileged families, we have participated in the Community Care Fund Assistance Programme to subsidise our needy students to purchase suitable portable computer devices. Blended mode of learning, i.e. face-to-face classes, e-learning at home or other modes of learning, will probably become the “new normal” in teaching and learning in future.

To further support schools in implementing the blended mode of teaching and learning under the “new normal”, the Education Bureau (EDB) will launch the “Quality Education Fund e-Learning Funding Programme—Provision of Portable Computer Devices and Internet Services Support” for three years starting from the 2021/22 school year. It includes providing funding to schools to purchase portable computer devices for loan to needy students and to provide portable Wi-Fi routers and mobile data cards for students who are unable to acquire appropriate Internet services due to their constraints of the living environment.

Eligible Beneficiaries:

Students are eligible if they fulfill the following requirements,

1. receiving Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (**CSSA**) from the Social Welfare Department; **or**
2. receiving **full grant** of School Textbook Assistance Scheme (STAS) in the 2021/22 school year; **or**
3. receiving **half grant** of School Textbook Assistance Scheme (STAS) in the 2021/22 school year

Details of subsidy on buying portable computer devices:

1. Students receiving the **CSSA** or **full grant** of the School Textbook Assistance Scheme are entitled to have a **full subsidy** to purchase a portable computer device. The maximum subsidy for each student is \$4,700. In other words, the subsidy provided is the actual cost of the device or \$4,700, whichever is lower.
2. Students receiving a **half grant** of the School Textbook Assistance Scheme are entitled to have a **half subsidy**. The subsidy provided is half of the actual cost of the device for up to HK\$2,350.
3. The purchased portable computer device and products Specification:
 - ✓ Apple iPad 9th generation 10.2-Inch 256GB Wi-Fi version
 - ✓ Apple pencil (1st generation)
 - ✓ Apple Care Apple Care 3 years' warranty
 - ✓ Protective Case and Screen Protector

Remarks:

1. Each beneficiary student can receive funding **once** only and purchase one mobile computer device.
2. The Education Bureau will issue **subsidies to schools for purchasing devices on behalf of students.**
