Registration procedure for S1 students

Welcome your child to Wai Kiu College. Please read the following guidelines for a smooth completion of registration.

(I) Guidelines for registration

(1) Registration

A	Complete the "Student Record Form" distributed by the school				
E	Submit the admission slip				
	Collect school notices				

(2) The first tuition fee

The first instalment of tuition fee must be paid on or before 1st August at 4:00 p.m. Parents may pay in cash or by post-dated cheque in person at the school office. As the cheque will be deposited on 2nd August, please date the cheque "1st August, 2024". If parents do not pay the first instalment of tuition on or before 1st August, the school place for the new academic year may not be retained. The tuition fee for September is as follows:

Secondary 1 Tuition fee for September	Tuition fee for the entire year
\$300-	\$3000- (Pay in 10 instalments, \$300- per month)

(3) Purchase of textbooks

Textbooks may be purchased from any bookstore and please pay attention to the medium of instruction of the subject when you make the purchase. For students who order textbooks through the school, the bookstore will make arrangements according to the class allocation.

(4) School uniforms

Students can order the school uniforms from the designated companies. Should parents purchase the school uniforms on their own, please ensure the school uniforms fulfil the requirements of our school.

(5) Lesson arrangements

Our school is a full-time grammar school adopting a "weekday" timetable. The official school hours are: Monday to Friday from 8:10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. S.1 to S.3 students are required to stay at school for lunch. S.4 to S.6 students are allowed to go out for lunch.

(6) Exercise books, Chinese manuscript papers, single-line papers

Students can purchase these items at the General Office after the new school year begins.

(7) Pre-Secondary One Hong Kong Attainment Test (Placement Test) and Class Allocation

The attainment test will be held in our school from 8:30 am to 12:45 pm on 16th July (Tuesday). Students should arrive school at 8:30 am. All new Secondary one students are required to attend and they should bring their Allocation Slips, identification documents and stationery back to school for the test. They are also required to submit photocopies of their Primary 6 report cards on the same day. In case of sick leave, parents should submit written documents explaining the reasons for the leave on or before 18th July, 2024 (Thursday).

If the Education Bureau announces suspension of school due to bad weather on the day of the test, the test will be held on the following day and the test time and other arrangements remain unchanged. Parents should pay attention to the public announcements made on the radio/the television or the government official webpage (www.gov.hk).

The results of class allocation will be announced and displayed in room 105 and 106 at 10:00 am on 19th July (Friday), and the book list will be distributed at that time.
